

## **Committees for SC / ST, OBC and Minorities**

To empower the students of SC / ST, OBC and Minorities, separate committees are formed as per the composition provided by the Statutory / Affiliating bodies. Committee members / Nodal Officers / SPOC have been appointed to look into the grievances of the students in regard to curricular / co-curricular / extra-curricular activities and also to assist them in receiving various scholarships.

## **Objectives**

- To ensure equal opportunities for education of SC / ST, OBC and minorities
- To facilitate financial support to students from these communities from governmental agencies and other sources
- To make these students aware of the various scholarships schemes of the Central and State Governments.
- To encourage these students to enrol for courses, workshops, programs, etc. which the College offers students in an attempt to equip them with the skills needed for their careers
- To provide prompt counselling for any emotional emergencies arising on account of any event on the College campus
- To provide these students with a grievance redressal mechanism in addition to the regular redressal mechanism

## **Functions and Activities**

- To publicize the various Central and State Government scholarship schemes and any updates in these matters by appointing a Nodal Officer as SPOC.
- To coordinate with other College Committees and to ensure these students participation in the activities
- To coordinate with Heads of Departments, Faculty advisors and the Mentor to identify students from these communities who need special assistance such as remedial classes and bridge courses, as well as those who are advanced learners and could be given extra attention and guidance for further progress.
- More exclusively, SC/ST students are permitted to make use of Book Bank Scheme and also, they were given concession in the lending period
